He’ll be bringing in binders of information he has compiled for his trips thus far and some research books he uses. This material will be available for you to peruse during the social period (6:30-7:00) and during any time we have left in the theatre after his program.

CALL FOR ART:

CPA’s upcoming exhibit at the Sertoma Arts Center in Raleigh. Cary Photographic Artists will have an exhibition at The Sertoma Arts Center, 1400 West Millbrook Road, Raleigh this Summer. The show will hang in early July 2017 and run through the end of August 2017. There is space for approximately 15 photographs.

The Sertoma Arts Center has long been an important part of the Raleigh’s arts programs. We have one of three exhibition spaces in the facility. This is an excellent venue for showing our work. Please Note: “All sales are coordinated by the Sertoma Arts Center. A 25% commission plus current NC sales tax goes to Sertoma Arts Center for each work sold.”

This will be a selective show. A committee will select the photographs to be exhibited from jpegs submitted with applications to participate in the show. The jpegs will be viewed anonymously (that is, without revealing the photographer) and graded by the selection committee. (Committee members will not grade their own submissions, if any.) The best photographs, as determined by the committee’s average grades, will be included in the exhibition. Only CPA members may participate in this exhibition.

As always, we want to have an impressive presentation. Exhibitors should plan to present work that is framed and matted, or otherwise presented, carefully. Because we have limited space, we discourage pieces wider than 28 inches. In some cases we may ask exhibitors to present their photographs in a smaller size than originally planned. We would like to include as many photographs as possible without crowding them.

Name, Email Address, Phone Number, Title of Each Photograph, Price of Each Photograph (or NFS). Jpeg Files of Each Photograph. The jpeg should be created from a file ready for printing; the exhibited print must match the jpeg file submitted., Frame Size (Width and Height).

You may submit either one or two photographs for this show. John will catalog the entries, but will not be on the selection committee. Scott will chair the selection committee which will not have access to the catalog of entries.




