EXHIBITIONS: CALL FOR PHOTOGRAPHS FOR CPA SHOWS:

DUKE HOSPITAL, DURHAM MARCH 1 - MAY 1, 2018 This exhibition is part of the Arts & Health at Duke Program and is located in the Arts & Health Gallery in the concourse between Duke Hospital and the Duke Medicine Pavilion. According to Duke, this concourse averages approximately 700 people through the space per hour.

This is a selective exhibit based on Duke A&H Program review, rules and guidelines.

Duke Hospital: "Our galleries are located in main public hallways of the hospital and clinics. These exhibits are viewed by patients, their families, visitors and staff.

When reviewing submissions we look for quality of art form, and a consistent and

cohesive body of work. Our intent is to exhibit work that is uplifting, provides a positive distraction and heightens the visitor experience at Duke Hospital and its clinics. Please keep this in mind when selecting artwork for consideration".

The Exhibits Committee asks that all submissions meet these requirements and that they be framed photos using a white mat and simple black frame only. No canvas wrap or prints on metal, etc. Maximum finished, frame width dimension not to exceed 20". **All submissions must be received by January 17, 2018.** Submissions will be reviewed, and submitted to Duke Hospital for review and acceptance, prior to final acceptance for the exhibit.

Arts & Health requests a contribution of 25% of all sales. This contribution is tax deductible.

Only CPA members may participate in this exhibition. You may submit either one or two photographs for this exhibit. If you are new to exhibiting, matting and framing tips can be found at www.caryphotographicartists.org.

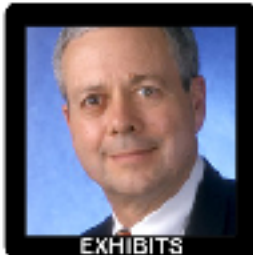
