To be viewed at their best via our projector, images should be sized per the following: vertical images - the tall side should be 1050 pixels, square images - 1050 pixels, horizontal images - the long side should be 1400pixels (height no more than 1050 pixels).

There is no theme or subject requirement. You may submit your best images or works in progress. We will have open discussion on the images as they are viewed.

June 27 - Tommy White: *Crafting your Masterpiece! Mastering your Vision to create Impact.* Tommy is a full time photographer in Boone with a background in art. See examples of his work [HERE](#).

He will discuss:

- “1) How to shoot for effect: The differences in using filters, exposure blending and other tricks to tame the light.
- 2) Planning your shoot: Reading the weather to get the most from your shoot. Choosing a weather specific location.
- 3) Vision: How to envision your shot, compose it, and capture what you see. Framing to maximize subject, balance and harmony.
- 4) You caught it, now the selection process: How to choose the correct image for editing and why is this important
- 5) Post Processing to meet your vision: Creating Impact and Mood - packed full of techniques and visual comparisons!!”
