The Beyond: Georgia O'Keeffe and Contemporary Art at NCMA through Jan 20. The show "brings together a significant group of O'Keeffe's works as the centerpiece of an exploration of her continued force as a touchstone for contemporary art alongside works by emerging artists that evoke and expand upon O'Keeffe's enchanting artistic language."

NCMA's *The Beyond* exhibit is ticketed with *Candida Höfer in Mexico*, large-format photographic "portraits" of 25 magnificent interiors of libraries, convents, theaters, churches, and museums throughout Mexico. Höfer's technical mastery of composition, light, and symmetry offers viewers a glimpse beneath the surface, toward the heart and character of each place.

- A supportive culture for raising the proficiencies of members.

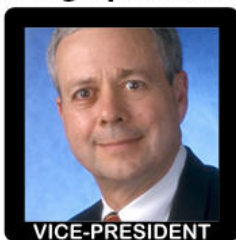

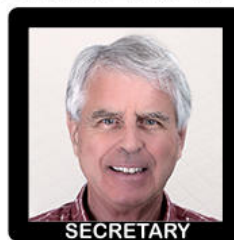

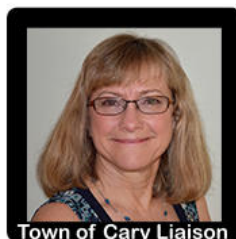
