Do you have an old Nikon D90 or 16GB memory card? If you would like to donate or sell it for CPA educational programs such as the Y Learning Photography Project, please contact Kathy Endres (kendres@nc.rr.com) by September 15th? A tax receipt can be provided.

We are also accepting monetary donations for the Nikon D90s we have purchased (\$200 each) and for any needed memory cards and holster bags.

These used cameras will provide Y Learning students at Reedy Creek Middle Creek Magnet Middle School a better photography experience than the point-and-shoot cameras used in the past. We don't intend to give these to the students, but rather keep them as "loaners". CPA will own them, and they'll be available for other educational programs. This change will reduce the annual Y Learning Photography Project's fundraising needs from \$2,200 to \$400.

Thanks to CPA and its members for all the heartwarming support you have shown to this outreach project. We hope this is our last financial solicitation to CPA members.
